

Bicol and Caraga region. In 2009, typhoon ketsana killed nearly 100 people. In 2012 typhoon Bopha hit Mindanao in South island of Philippines. In the south Philippines, the tropical storm Washi caused 1080 people to die. The coastal city Cagayande Oro destroyed. In 2013, typhoon Haiyan killed about 6000 people. Near about 650,000 people moved to go.

Vietnam

Vietnam is a country in South East Asia . It is surrounded by South China sea. From June to November, we see harsh weather here. People are left homeless for continuous rain. Agriculture land, specially rice fields are flooded and wasted. In northern Vietnam, there was a lot of damage in rain.

In June, 2018, Lai Chau Province, 470 km north west of Hanoi, killed 12 people due to disaster. In October, 2017, 8000 hectors of rice was wasted due to flood. Near about 40,000 animals are dead. In September 17,2018, typhoon Mongkhut hit northern and central Vietnam.

A terrible earthquake occurred in September, 2018. Near about, 1649 people in town of Palu, Sulawesi island has died. More than thousands of missing. Balaroa and Petoboa are about to be wiped out of the map. Diseases, epidemics, are occurring everywhere. In Dec, 2004, Tsunami killed 250,000 people and 37063 people missing, according to the country's National Disaster Relief coordination Agency.

In 2016, where 22 million tourists are here, the number decreases to 14 million 2017.

Turkey

Turkey is located in western Asia. The coastal country Turkey is surrounded by the Medeterian sea and Agegean sea. The climate of Turkey is medeterian. But natural disaster are inextricably linked to Turkey. From 1955 to 1995, 1000 people died at flood. Turkey was severely damaged by flood in 2009 .Marmara region in north western Turkey badly affected in this year . In May , 2018 there is a flood in Ankara for continuous heavy rain . Some suburban area was Submerged by flood .The commercial area of Ankara was submerged totally . Near about 160 vehicles go to flood water.

Japan

Japan is an island of the pacific ocean. It is located east coast of Asian continent. It's weather condition is mainly temperate. But natural disasters have made the coastal region crash. The flash flood and landslides have created in the mid and western part of Japan. Even the marine creature are badly affected with this disasters. Many marine turtles have died. 


Figure 3 Source- https://goo.gl/images/gLExrw

these places are the most damaged. Railway infrastructure is the worst hit in Andhra Pradesh and Orissa. Cyclone Hudhud ,Vishakhapatnam and neighboring districts Srikakulam and Vizeanagram have done a great deal of damage . Near about 8000 people of Tamilnadu died in Tsunami 2004. Tamil Nadu's Nagapattinam, Chennai, Cuddalore, Velan Kanni and Pmpuhar suffered huge losses.
